1. Revocation of the General Practice Data for Planning and Research Directions 2021

- 1.1 I am writing on behalf of the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care (the Secretary of State) to revoke the General Practice Data for Planning and Research Directions 2021 (the 2021 Directions) given to the Health and Social Care Information Centre (NHS Digital) on 6 April 2021.
- 1.2 These Directions come into force on the day after the day on which this letter is signed.
- 1.3 These Directions are given in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 254(1) and (6), 260(2)(d), 261(2)(e) and 304(9) to (12) of the Health and Social Care Act 2012¹ and regulation 32 of the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (Constitution and Functions) and the Health and Social Care Information Centre (Functions) Regulations 2013².

On 19 July 2021 a Ministerial letter³ was sent to general practices which set out four commitments that would be met before data collection pursuant to the 2021 Directions commenced.
