

1 The Court, having considered Defendant Western Digital Technologies, Inc.'s *Ex*  
2 *Parte* Application for Stay of Execution of Judgment Under Federal Rule of Civil  
3 Procedure 62 hereby **DENIES** this Application, except as follows: The Court stays  
4 enforcement of the Judgment for seven days from the date of this order to allow for  
5 further discussions and/or the filing of a bond. The Court has concerns about potential  
6 corporate restructuring, particularly given the fact the Judgment is against only  
7 Western Digital Technologies, Inc. The analysis would obviously be different if the  
8 corporate structure as a whole were a defendant or stood behind the judgment in some  
9 other capacity.
