WARRANT TO SEIZE PROPERTY SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE

ATTACHMENT A-2

With respect to “lum-market.fun” (“SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2”), Dynadot LLC, who is the domain registrar for SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2, shall take the following actions to effectuate the seizure of SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2:

5. Take all reasonable measures to redirect the domain names to substitute servers at the direction of the FBI, by associating the SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 to the following authoritative name-server(s):
 - d. hans.ns.cloudflare.com;
 - e. surina.ns.cloudflare.com; and/or
 - f. Any new authoritative name server to be designated by a law enforcement agent in writing, including e-mail, to Dynadot.
6. Prevent any further modification to, or transfer of, SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 pending transfer of all right, title, and interest in SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 to the United States upon completion of forfeiture proceedings, to ensure that changes to SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 cannot be made absent court order or, if forfeited to the United States, without prior consultation with the FBI.
7. Take all reasonable measures to propagate the necessary changes through the Domain Name System as quickly as practicable.
8. Provide reasonable assistance in implementing the terms of this Order and take no unreasonable action to frustrate the implementation of this Order.

Some time after SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 is associated with the authoritative name-server(s), but no later than May 21, 2025, the Government may display a notice on the website to which SUBJECT DOMAIN NAME 2 will resolve. That notice may consist of law enforcement emblems and the following text (or substantially similar text):

“This domain has been seized by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in accordance with a seizure warrant issued by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas as part of a law enforcement action against the LummaC2 malware service, its administrators, and its subscribers.

This action has been taken in coordination with the National Security Division of the Department of Justice.

The FBI also acknowledges that private sector actors seized other domains in a separate and independent operation pursuant to civil injunctive relief granted by another federal court.
