## HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE PURUSHAINDRA KUMAR KAURAV ORDER 30.07.2025

1. Mr. Rajiv Nayar and Mr. Dayan Krishnan, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, pointed out at the outset, that in the *interregnum*, the services of the petitioner have been restored by the respondents.
